THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRICT OF PINAWA

BY-LAW NO. 635-02

Being a By-law for the LGD of Pinawa to prohibit the feeding of deer within the Townsite of Pinawa.

WHEREAS Section 232(1)(k) of the Municipal Act, being Chapter M225 of the Revised Statutes of Manitoba states:

"A Council may pass by-laws for municipal purposes respecting the following matters:

(k) wild and domestic animals and activities in relationship to them...."

AND WHEREAS Section 249 (1), (2), (3) of the Municipal Act provides for as follows:

"A person who contravenes a by-law of a municipality is guilty of an offence and, if the by-law imposes no other penalty, is liable on summary conviction to a fine of no more than \$500. or to imprisonment for a term of not more than three months."

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and desirable to prohibit the feeding of deer within the Townsite of Pinawa;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the LGD of Pinawa enacts as follows:

- 1. Except as otherwise provided in this By-law, no person shall:
 - a) Feed deer in the Townsite of Pinawa or approach by holding out or setting out foodstuffs or bait of any kind.
- 2. A person who contravenes this by-law shall be guilty of an offence is liable on summary conviction to a fine of not more than \$500.
