

## RECYCLING PROGRAM

**Recycling MUST be at the curbside by 8:00 am.**

More than half of your household waste can be recycled. The following are accepted items for your recycling bin.



### Plastic

All food and beverage plastic\* bottles, jugs, tubs and trays with the numbers 1 through 7 on the bottom, can be recycled.

Plastic 1-7

**NO:** Rubbermaid products, caulking tubes, plastic or foam dishes, motor oil jugs, grocery bags, plastic wrap, styrofoam, toys or other durable plastics.

\* Please do not include foam, plastic packaging, plastic bags, plastic wrap, and "blisterpak" plastics (e.g. the rigid clear plastic packaging on toys and other products).

### Paper

**Household paper:** Includes flyers, auto and real estate listings, door hangers, advertisements, ad mail, computer paper, envelopes (with window removed), egg cartons, and paper rolls.

**NO:** tissues, waxed paper or paper towels

**Corrugated cardboard:** Must be CLEAN and unwaxed. Remove all food residue from pizza boxes.

### Newspapers, magazines and telephone directories:

Includes catalogues, paperback books and hardcover books with covers removed. \*Residents are encouraged to donate books to local charities.

**Boxboard boxes:** Includes shoe, cereal, tissue and detergent boxes. Remove liners and plastic windows, then flatten.

### Containers

**Food and beverage metal cans:** Rinse. Put loose lids inside can and pinch closed.

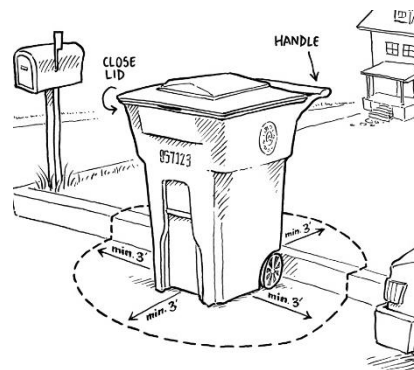
**NO:** coat hangers, cooking pots or pans, utensils, batteries.

**Food and beverage glass bottles & jars:** Rinse and remove lids.

**NO:** drinking glasses, dishes, cups, crystal, window glass, light bulbs, glass pots & pans, mirrors, pottery or make-up jars.

**Aluminum:** Rinse to remove food and grease. **NO:** foil or trays with food scraps or grease, foil with paper or plastic lamination (chip bags, foil wrap from butter, blister foil from pill containers or cigarette wrappers).

Please remember the following on collection day. Place cart with wheels to the curb, do not overfill or place items on top of the cart, do not place non-recyclable items in the cart and make sure there is a 3m perimeter around the cart.



The Recycling Depot located on Lagoon Road, approximately 1.5 km West of Pinawa on the South side of Highway 211, is open 7 days per week from 8:00 am – 8:00 pm for residents of Pinawa..

### PLASTIC BAG RECYCLING

In Manitoba, plastic bags are not accepted in your recycling bin. Fortunately, many retailers in Manitoba accept your used plastic bags. Remember, reduce your use of plastic bags by bringing a reusable option, reuse "single-use" bags for household garbage, pet waste and other items, and finally, recycle the ones already in your home.

## GARBAGE COLLECTION

A maximum of (2) garbage containers are allowed per home on garbage day, size restrictions outlined in By-law 796-15. No loose garbage is allowed in containers. Persons occupying a Residential Premise may place for curbside collection, additional containers of Landfill Waste by purchasing, in advance, for \$1.00, a Surcharge Sticker/Tag available from the Municipal Office.

Additional containers of Landfill Waste at the curb for collection which do not have a Surcharge Sticker/Tag will not be collected. **Garbage MUST be at the curbside by 8:00 am.**

### Tipping Fees - Contractors and Residents

Small load (in excess of two bags of waste) .....	\$20.00
1-ton Truck or Trailer.....	\$45.00
3-ton truck .....	\$80.00
Tandem.....	\$125.00
Semi-Trailer .....	\$185.00

Household appliances containing freon must be tagged “Freon Free” or “CFC Free”. Any appliance without this tag will be charged \$25.00 to cover the cost of drainage. If your appliance is tagged, the tipping fee will not apply.

**No charge for tires, scrap steel, e-waste, or yard waste.**

No contractor is allowed to enter or use the landfill site unless approved and arranged with the LGD of Pinawa and a payment schedule set with the LGD at 753-5100 prior to use.

## Household Hazardous Waste

The Landfill Site houses a Household Hazardous Waste Building. These wastes should not be thrown away with your regular household garbage or poured down your drain. The following items are accepted at the Household Hazardous Waste Building at the Landfill Site:

Household paint, flammable liquids and waste gasoline, pesticides, toxics, corrosives and non-refillable fuel gas cylinders, fluorescent light bulbs.

Products must be in their original container with label intact. Containers must be tightly sealed. Gasoline must be returned in approved gas can or jerry can. Do not mix different types of products together.

We cannot accept commercial, industrial or agricultural products; fertilizer, mercury switches, automotive paint, craft paint, paint in glass containers, brushes, rags and rollers, refillable propane cylinders, ammunition, drugs and medicines, caulking compound, diesel, medical sharps, insect repellants, disinfectants and pet products, cosmetics.

Oil is not accepted at the Pinawa Landfill Site or the Recycling Depot. Oil can be taken to the #313 Transfer Station, located on PR Highway 313 (near the PR 520 junction). To view the RM Transfer Station #313 hours visit [www.lacdubonnet.com](http://www.lacdubonnet.com).

## Electronic Waste

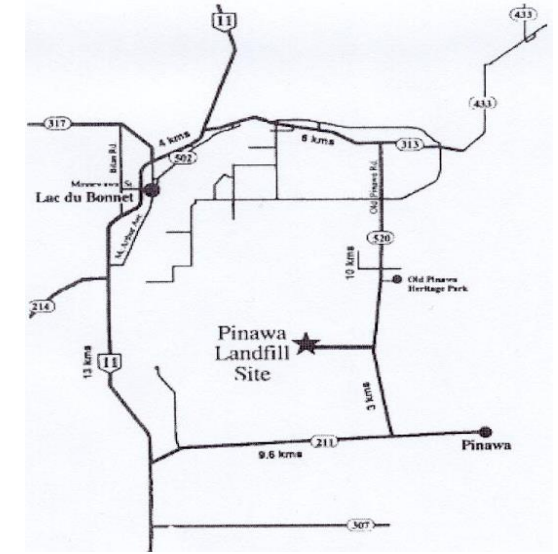
The following electronic items are accepted at the Landfill Site.

Monitors, TVs, computers and related components, electronic calculators, photocopiers, telephones, fax machines, VCRs, DVD players, typewriters, printers, mobile radios and FRS phones, microwaves, remote controls, play stations, answering machines, cameras and electrical equipment.

By-law No. 796-15, outlining the rules and regulations on the Waste Management System is available at the Municipal Office.

The LGD of Pinawa reserves the right to amend the Landfill Site By-law as required.

## YARD WASTE COLLECTION

### May – October

Yard waste pickup will occur every Monday, with the exception of statutory holidays. **Yard Waste MUST be at the curbside by 8:00 am.**

The following must be adhered to for yard waste pickup

- Small materials such as leaves and plants should be placed in clearly marked certified paper bags, or in reusable container
- Branches must be bundled and tied and should not exceed 4 feet in length and 4 inches in diameter.
- Plastic bags are no longer accepted for leaf and yard waste collection.
