

## MATERIALS ACCEPTED AT THE DEPOT

**Glass:** Bottles, etc. Broken glass and light bulbs not accepted.

### **Tin (steel) cans, other steel materials:**

Paint cans must be empty, paint dry. Telephone about large steel materials (baler limits size).

**Aluminum materials:** Beverage cans, pie plates, some pet food containers, sardine cans, foil, etc.

**#1 Plastics:** Pop and water bottles, food containers, etc.

**#2,4,5,7 plastics:** Margarine, food, produce containers. Detergent and shampoo bottles, milk jugs, etc. **Plastic films:** recycle shopping bags, etc. that have the recycling symbol on them.

**Newspapers/flyers/catalogues/glossy paper/magazines/telephone books, paperbacks:** Into the newspaper bins.

**Boxboard:** Cereal, cracker, cookie, etc. boxes. White and colored paper (including shredded), wrapping paper, pet food bags, envelopes (with and without windows), used coloring books. Manuals, hard cover books, etc. **Leave shredded paper in bags.**

**Corrugated cardboard:** Flatten boxes. Remove packaging.

**Gable end cartons and tetrapaks:** Cartons – milk, juice, etc. Tetrapaks – juice, soups, bouillon, etc.

**Please remove caps/lids from plastics and rinse them.**

## RESIDENTIAL ELECTRONIC WASTE

Below is a list of e-waste that will be accepted for recycling. Take these items to the **Landfill Site** during the hours of operation listed. Please do not leave at the Recycling Depot.

### E-WASTE ACCEPTED

- Computer cables with or without connectors
- Computer cards such as sound, video, network, modems, controllers
- Circuit boards from computers, printers, fax and scanners
- Internal or external CD-ROMs, DVD and CD-ROM burners
- Electronic typewriters
- Fax machines
- Hard disks (HD) and floppy drives (FD)
- Laptops, laptop parts
- Laptop accessories, chargers, batteries, cables and cards
- External modems
- Networking equipment, cards, hubs, routers, switches, cabling
- Personal computers (CPU, monitors, keyboards, mouse and peripherals)
- Inkjet and Laser printers
- Software manuals, DCs, DVDs and Diskettes
- Cassette and reel tape players/recorders
- Mobile radios and FRS phones
- Microwaves
- Remote controls (television and stereo)
- Game decks (Play Station, X-box, Nintendo)
- Cell phones, chargers and batteries
- Pagers and answering machines
- Batteries, dry-cell and rechargeable
- Stereos, televisions, entertainment equipment
- Regular telephones (corded or wireless)
- Electrical equipment (lawnmowers, panels, heaters, motors, chargers, drills, blowers, generators, etc.)

## PINAWA LANDFILL SITE - TIPPING FEES

Construction/Demolition Waste

### Residents

1 ton Truck or Trailer.....	\$45.00
3 ton truck .....	\$80.00
Tandem.....	\$125.00
Semi-Trailer .....	\$185.00

### Contractors

Pick-up Truck or Trailer.....	\$20.00
1 ton truck or trailer .....	\$45.00
3 ton truck .....	\$80.00
Tandem.....	\$125.00
Semi-Trailer .....	\$185.00

### REMINDERS

- On collection day all garbage must be at the curbside by 8 a.m.
- Only two (2) garbage containers are allowed per home on garbage day; size restrictions outlined in By-law No. 796-15.
- Yard Waste is allowed only on Mondays and must be in a paper yard waste bag.
- No loose garbage allowed in containers.
- If garbage day falls on a holiday, pickup will be the day after the holiday.
- Garbage schedule is as follows:
  - Stage One Wednesday
  - Stage Two Thursday
  - Stage Three Thursday
  - Business Tuesday/Friday

### HOURS OF OPERATION

#### Summer

(May 1 – October 31)

Saturday: 8 am – 1 pm  
Sunday: Noon – 5 pm

Tuesday and Thursday  
5 pm – 8 pm

#### Winter

(November 1 – April 30)

Saturday  
8 am – 1 pm

Tuesday  
5 pm – 8 pm

During above hours any resident may deposit garbage, grass, branches, etc. **FREE OF CHARGE** by presenting your Authorization Card available at the Municipal Office.

## BY-LAW NO. 796-15 SURCHARGES

Persons occupying a Residential Premise may place for curbside collection, additional containers of Landfill Waste by purchasing, in advance, for \$1.00, a Surcharge Sticker/Tag available from the Municipal Office.

Additional containers of Landfill Waste at the curb for collection which do not have a Surcharge Sticker/Tag will not be collected.

Refrigerators, freezers & air conditioners must be tagged “Freon Free” or “CFC Free”. Any appliance without this tag will be charged \$25.00 to cover the cost of drainage. If your appliance is tagged, the tipping fee will not apply.

No resident or contractor is allowed to enter or use the landfill site unless approved and arranged with the LGD of Pinawa and a payment schedule set with the LGD at 753-5100 prior to use.

By-law No. 796-15, outlining the rules and regulations on the Waste Management System is available at the Municipal Office.

## PINAWA RECYCLING INC.

Located approximately 1.5 km West of Pinawa on the South side of Highway 211.

### 24 hour bin drop –off

#### AT HOME

- Look for the recycling symbol on plastic materials.
- Put all plastics with no symbol into your household garbage.

**PUT ALL #3 AND #6 PLASTICS INTO YOUR HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE (Styrofoam, some bottles and produce containers)**

PLEASE! Rinse all containers!

No need to remove labels.

Remove all container lids. Recycle steel and plastic lids with symbols. Put plastic lids with no symbol into household garbage.

#### REMEMBER

Put recyclables in correct bins.

**Shred all sensitive papers that could be used to steal your identity.**

#### HAZARDOUS WASTES

The Recycling Depot cannot accept leftover paint, paint thinners, insecticides, oil, etc.
