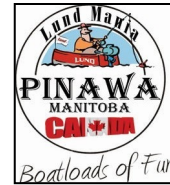


LUND MANIA

2017 TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Entrants must follow all Manitoba angling and boating regulations. If a tournament official should find that an entrant was fishing in violation of these regulations, that team will be disqualified from the tournament.
- Only **Lund** boats are eligible to participate in the LUND Mania Tournament.
- The LUND Mania Tournament will follow the C.P.R. (Catch, Photo & Release) format.
- Fishing hours are from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm, Sat. July 15, 2017. Blast off and check in location will be at the Pinawa Marina. Contestants will leave by a trickle start. Tournament boundaries are areas accessible by water. Launch locations and parking instructions will be announced during the Friday evening Rules Meeting. Tournament Anglers should be at the tournament headquarters at or before 7:00 am to pick up their Spotters and scorecards. **NOTE! Spotters are not allowed to bring GPS units.**
- As a C.P.R. based tournament, the weigh-in practice represents that it is the responsibility of the entrants to make sure that their scorecard is turned into the officials before 3:00pm. Saturday. There will be an official on the water, near the dock and one on the dock. Late arrivals will be penalized one (1) lb. per minute, up to five minutes at which time they will lose their entire weight. No scorecards will be accepted after that time.
- An official Lund Judge Ruler will be provided to every team. **It is the responsibility of the team to bring a digital camera with a blank camera memory card.** Tournament officials will obtain all blank camera memory cards during the Rules Meeting on Friday evening. The cards will be returned to each team on Saturday morning prior to blast off. **All teams must take a validation picture with date on Sat. July 15th prior to blast off.**
- Entrants will receive the weight of their 6 largest walleye for prizes. Fish cannot be retained or put in the live well! When a fish is caught, the fish will be placed on the official Judge Ruler by the angler and the Spotter will verify the two pictures of the fish. The Spotter will confirm the length with the angler, write it on the official scorecard, initial it and have the angler initial it. If there is a discrepancy in length, the Spotter's decision is final. If either initial is not present, the fish will not be counted. (Make sure you and your Spotter initial the official scorecard.) The Angler must release all fish within 60 seconds, after recording length. In the event of a tie, the heaviest fish will be awarded the higher prize.
- Lund Mania Tournament officials will convert length to weight. Converted weights will be displayed.
- It is also mandatory that Anglers and Spotters must be in possession of certified and U.S. and Canadian Coast Guard approved PFD's. These will be supplied by the boat Captain, and must be worn at anything over trolling speed. All boats must have an engine kill switch, which must also be used over trolling speed. All contestants must display their boat entry number on their motor. (port-side)
- No cell phones except for emergencies and boats cannot touch each other or pass objects between boats during tournament hours.
- All teams must be off the water and any pre-fishing completed by 4:00 pm Friday, July 14th.
- Spotters will be drawn for boat placement prior to the tournament at the rules meeting on Friday, July 14th at 7:00pm at the Pinawa Community Centre with dinner starting at 6:00pm. **Anglers and Spotters must attend.** Tournament officials will have the right to change spotter placements at their discretion.
- The safety of the Spotter will be the responsibility of the Anglers of the boat. Please use common sense with reference to weather and water conditions. If dangerous conditions arise, a boat may go to shore until conditions improve. However, no fishing is allowed until back on the water.
- Tournament organizers will endeavor to supply a Spotter for every boat, however if for any reason this cannot be done and something else cannot be worked out, the entrant will receive their entry fee back.
- The intent of the tournament is to promote good angling practices and good sportsmanship. In the event of any disputes between tournament entrants, a final and binding decision will be made by the tournament judge(s) appointed. If you wish to put in protest, it must be done with-in 1 hour of the tournament closing time, and you will need to provide a \$200 cash fee, which will be refunded, only if the judges decide the protest holds up.
- All teams must check in at the dock at the end of the day whether they weigh-in or not.
- The top 10 finishing teams will be notified at weigh-in and will take part in the Top 10 weigh in festivities (This will be held on the main stage under the big tent).
- Anglers shall not fish in waters 30 feet or deeper .

PARTICIPATION RELEASE—READ BEFORE SIGNING

In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in the 2017 Lund Mania Fishing Tournament, the Undersigned, acknowledge, appreciate and agree that:

- The risk of injury from the activities involved in this tournament is significant, including the potential for permanent paralysis and death, and while particular rules equipment and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of injury does exist; and
- I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of the releases or others, and assume full responsibility for my participations; and
- I willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for participation. If, however, I observe any unusual significant hazard during my presence or participation, I will remove myself from participation and bring such to the attention to the nearest official immediately; and
- I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representation and next of kin, hereby release, indemnify and hold harmless Lund Boat Company, their officials, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event, with respect to any and all injury, disability, death or loss or damage to person or property, arising from the negligence of the releases or otherwise, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- In the event that there are more than 50 entries, a "first come, first serve" will be used to determine which teams will be competing in the LUND Mania Fishing Tournament should a spot open up.
