**11.4 Grant Application – Canadian Red Cross for Fire Department**

Whereas the Canadian Red Cross has announced a grant designed to enhance regional wildfire response and emergency management capabilities, including the strengthening of preparedness for both wildfire and major structural fire scenarios;

And Whereas the Fire Chief has prepared a grant application to the Canadian Red Cross to bolster these response efforts within Pinawa, the Whiteshell, and the broader mutual aid district;

And Whereas the grant will facilitate the purchase of essential emergency response equipment and specialized technology, including a drone;

And Whereas the operational impact of this aerial technology will be instrumental in developing

precise incident action plans, significantly improving response efficacy for: Wildfires and large-scale structural fires, Lost person searches and Water rescue events;  
 Therefore be it resolved that the Council of the LGD of Pinawa hereby supports the grant application submitted to the Canadian Red Cross. CARRIED.
